

15 YEAR MANUFACTURING WARRANTY



Solution Dyed Nylon (Type 6'6) Carpet Tile product manufactured by Interface

Subject to the qualifications in paragraphs (1) and (2) below, if

- a) the products nominated in this warranty are installed inside commercial premises.
 - b) the nominated product is installed by an Interface approved layer and maintained in accordance with Interface's published technical recommendations as at the date of initial purchase, and
 - c) the nominated product suffers from any one of more of the following manufacturing defects:
 - Separation of the primary backing from the backing system – that when tested in accordance with specification AS2111-16 the bond strength does not meet the specifications published in the Carpet Institute of Australia's Technical Bulletin No.1
 - Failure of the tuft bind – that when tested in accordance with specification AS2111 – 15 the nominated product will withstand up to 6 newtons force for the removal of an individual tuft of cut pile and up to 30 newtons force for the removal of an individual loop pile.
 - Change of colour – that the nominated product shall meet Interface published specifications for colourfastness to light, water shampoo, rubbing dry and rubbing wet,
 - Cupping and doming – that the nominated product meets specification ISO 2551
 - d) In the event outlined in clause (c) has resulted from a defect in the product and not from the conduct of the customer.
 - e) Within fifteen (15) years from the date of installation of new product, Interface will replace or repair (at Interface's option) each such defective tile at Interface's expense and pay the costs of installation of replacement product or repair at prevailing furnishing trade rates.
1. Any additional costs whether directly or indirectly related (including the moving of partitioning, workstations, furniture or wiring) will not be the responsibility of Interface.
 2. If requested by Interface a sample of 1.5 square metres of the affected product must be furnished to Interface for testing to verify any complaint.

To the extent permitted by law, the rights contained in this warranty preclude the reliance on all other rights, either statutory or common law. The customer acknowledges that in the event of a defect, it will only exercise those rights as are set out in this warranty.
